

Solar Maps Version 3 – New Features

- New and improved maps. Zoom in to much greater precision of coastlines and lakes.
- Advanced map color options - more attractive and more readable maps.
- Zoom mouse mode now highlights nearest stored map to zoom into
- New mouse mode cursors to make it clearer which mouse mode is active
- New mouse mode button to allow relocation reports just by clicking on the map
- All mouse modes now work with single click
- Previous map views now listed by description instead of filename
- Hurricanes/Earthquake mapping - Sample files of major earthquakes and north atlantic storms and hurricanes are included. More can be imported from the web.
- Midpoint Astro-mapping Lines
- Planet Aspects Astro-mapping Lines
- Parans have been extended to allow paran lines for more than one planet
- Solar Arc directions have been added to Subsidiary charts
- Sec.Progs + Transits now available on same chart display (as in CycloCartoGraphy)
- Now you can retain the natal local space line directions when you relocate the chart
- New copy options to save image as BMP/GIF to clipboard/file or email attachment
- New web and email options added to help menu
- When relocating a chart now you automatically jump to the nearest city by clicking on map

- ACS Atlas is embedded in Version 3 offering more than 250,000 places from around the world. Version 1 & 2 owners, please note that if you already have a stand-alone ACS Atlas, Solar Maps will use this in preference to the embedded Atlas.

- It is now possible to step or run a chart through time while your astro-mapping lines are displayed on any map of the world. You can animate any type of chart, either natal or subsidiary (transits to natal, secondary progressed, tertiary progressed and solar arc directed).
