





The Sun

Sun Sign Astrology is very popular in modern times. Many people know their own Sun Sign. And it has become a common occurrence for personal introductions to include a reference to a person's Sun Sign. Just as the Sun is the centre of the earth's Solar System, so does the Sun play a vital role in your life on earth. Your personality and self-expression are linked to your Sun - its Zodiac Sign and its position in your chart. So, it's no wonder that Sun Signs have risen in recognition.

The Sun moves around the Zodiac every year and so you share your birthday and Sun Sign with many others. You can see enough similarities to pique your interest in astrology. It's important to note the Sun isn't the only planet to be considered in a person's chart, but it is an important component.

You have the innate ability to make even the smallest of tasks a joyful experience for yourself and others. You also have the ability to explore areas of life where others fear to venture such as the mysteries of afterlife, and the expansive nature of the universe. You may also have a love of history, the root of languages, ancient civilisations and genealogy, as these things can shed light on present day events. In short, you have a gift for the getting of wisdom.

And now to your love life. The planet of love Venus is strongly linked to your love life, as are some other key points in your Birth Chart. However, your Sun Sign also plays a role. Your Sun Sign is how you express yourself as an individual and also within relationships. As a Sagittarius, you have a love of life and a love of adventure. You like to explore ideas, and you may also like to travel. Therefore, your love life is likely to be lit up by a fellow Sagittarius, or an Aries or Leo. Gemini, Libra and Aquarius people may also appeal. You are less likely to be compatible with Taurus, Virgo and Capricorn Sun Signs. And Water Sun Signs – Cancer and Scorpio – are unlikely to light your fire. It is possible that a Pisces could spark your imagination. You need to find someone who can appreciate your love of life, and who is happy to create quality times together, while also enabling you to have the freedom to explore some of your own interests.

Self-care is something that is important. Naturally, life's challenges need to be faced but there is also a need to occasionally escape when problems seem overwhelming. Escape is defined as 'breaking free of confinement or control'. In this instance, 'escape' is from the confinement of seemingly insurmountable obstacles of 21st Century living. How do you like to get away? And what type of self-care helps revive you and support your personality? Perhaps you will recognise yourself in your Sun Sign, and you may discover further tips by reading your Moon Sign in the next section of this report.

Sagittarius is a Fire Sign so spontaneity is a key factor in self-care. You are likely to want to escape to the great outdoors. The Sun is in the 4th House

While this report focuses on the Sign of your Sun, it's also prudent to look at where your Sun is placed in your Birth Chart in relation to the Rising Sign, which sets different sectors. In astrology, these sectors are called the 'Houses' and indicate the areas of life through which your planets are expressed. Your Sun is in the 4th House of your Birth Chart meaning that your home and family play a powerful role in your life, as they are the vehicle for you learning about life. For this reason, you expend much time and energy working out your role in the family. Family life, and even family conflict, provides you with opportunities to learn about your own resources. Love them or hate them, you can't seem to escape them unless it is to form a new family of your own. Although you do love your family members, as you mature you also feel a strong urge to leave the nest and put down roots of your own. You benefit from purchases of land, houses, and property, and may also benefit from working in jobs connected with property. You're likely to achieve your ambitions for a secure home, although at times you can feel quite unsettled if your housing situation is unclear. Astrologically speaking, the Sun is strong in the angular 4th House of a chart, and therefore whether you realise it or not you're likely to make a strong impact on your family members. You also benefit through inheritances from parents or family members.

The Moon

Astrologers from different schools of thought allocate varying meanings to the Moon in a Birth Chart. Ancient astrologers say that the Moon changes its nature according to its phases, and merely passes on impressions from other planets rather than directly influencing a person's life. In other words, the Moon is said to reflect the light of other planets, emphasising them or shading them.

Modern astrologers tell us that the Moon depicts a person's roots, our home and family. They say the Moon also shows our habitual nature or subconscious patterns of behaviour which stand in the way of achieving our life goals. Modern astrology advises understanding our emotion nature and with it so that we can express our needs in a positive way.

Another form, Esoteric Astrology or astrology of the soul, tells us that the Moon represent the past, the obstacles that we need to overcome so that we can fulfil our soul's purpose. The Moon, according to Esoteric Astrology, is our past karma that blocks our soul's progress. So they suggest suppressing our needs as depicted by the Moon.

The approach in this report is that while the Moon can show us our strengths, it can also depict our weaknesses which need to be overcome in order to be successful in life.

The Moon is in Gemini

With the Moon in the sign of Gemini you enjoy nothing more than a good discussion, often taking a controversial tack simply to cross swords with others on an intellectual level. It also doesn't particularly worry you if the discussion becomes a little emotional, as you're adept at talking your way around most things. In fact, talking and arguing are activities at which you excel. You may even find yourself on a debating team. Your friends may label you a chatterbox as you seem to have something to say on every subject. You have a wonderful sense of humour which can get you, and others out of tricky situations. Your light-hearted approach to serious subjects can be a source of joy for you and your loved ones. You are a regular Peter Pan or Tinkerbell when it comes to life. You do not like to be bored and so need to keep your mind occupied with books, television, social activities and sometimes chores (as long as they are not too onerous or tedious). You're curious and seek answers to many questions, and often have several projects on the go at once. Telephones, televisions, newspapers, computers, radios and books may all feature in your life, as you investigate the many avenues capable of providing extra information. You also love travelling in your car, or by public transport, as it gives you a feeling of going places, although you can lose

your sense of direction.

Money matters. Whether you like it or not money is needed to survive in the 21st century. And everyone has a money story that has been passed on down through their family history, and is in situ when born. This could be a story of struggle, comfort or riches. As your money journey unfolds, and then later the story unravels, it's likely to have emotions associated with it. The Moon is the seat of emotions and so is intricately linked to your money story, and resultant money mindset. Money is often the exchange of emotions, and vice versa emotions affect how money flows. In learning more about your emotions, and their link to money, you can step into a more positive and powerful place in your life, and experience the flow of money that you most desire. Understanding your Moon Sign in your Horoscope can accelerate this process. It's a case of easy come, easy go with most things in your life. And this includes money. You crave excitement, variety and distractions. Money is a reflection of your emotional state. When you are in sync and feel motivated then money flows easily in and out. But when you are stressed or bored, you struggle to balance the books. Impulsive spending, and perhaps even gambling, can upset the equilibrium. Credit cards are not a good friend for anyone with a Gemini Moon. It's too easy to aim for instant gratification when you are feeling off balance and then pay later. It's important for you to look after your emotional state, and to do things that nurture your need for variety and stimulation. A positive money mindset is vital when your Moon is in Gemini. This is because your emotions are ruled by the wily planet Mercury, who can play tricks on your mind. You need to stop worrying. Let your money-making ideas flow, and then seek sound advice on how to proceed. As Gemini is the Zodiac Sign of duality, you could seek two forms of advice. Money mindset books, podcasts and courses can also be a great way to proceed, giving you vital information. While your emotions influence your own emotional state, you are able to detach and give advice to other people. You could earn your living through giving advice (financial or otherwise), teaching, writing or networking.

Let's look at one way of nurturing your Moon and that is through the art of aromatherapy. Like astrology, aromatherapy is an ancient craft. And while nothing replaces a professional consultation, you can explore the sensual world of aromatherapy by introducing some oils via Zodiac Signs. You could apply the following tips to your Sun and Rising Sign as well, but the Moon is the seat of emotions and responds well to positive effects of scent and touch. Also, the sense of smell is most closely linked to memory and emotions, and this connects directly to the astrological Moon. You may choose aromatherapy oils that enhance or strengthen your traits, or ones that calm or soothe. In your case your Moon is in Gemini and so, lavender, thyme and eucalyptus can help with respiratory problems. Basil, bergamot, grapefruit and ginger are great for nurturing a quick mind! Other useful oils are jasmine, geranium and neroli. For mental fatigue: peppermint and lemongrass.

The Moon is in the 10th House

While this report focuses on the Sign of your Moon, it's also prudent to look at where your Moon is placed in your Birth Chart in relation to the Rising Sign, which sets different sectors. In astrology, these sectors are called the 'Houses' and indicate the areas of life through which your planets are expressed. The Moon is placed in the 10th House of your Birth Chart suggesting that you're ambitious and enjoy your job, spending much time in the workplace, working odd hours to make sure that you get ahead in your career. You've a need to be publicly recognised for your achievements, and this need may or may not be satisfied during your lifetime. It's likely that you succeed in your chosen profession at some stage during your life, but whether or not this success is enduring depends on other sections of your Birth Chart. It's true to say that your professional life undergoes several changes during the course of your life, with rises to fame and popularity, and possible falls from grace. You're also likely to

move into a completely different field of work at least once in your lifetime.

You may be prominent in your field, popular with the public. The more that you express your emotional truth in public the more vulnerable you are likely to feel and yet, this will also ultimately earn you other people's heartfelt respect. Your mother is likely to have played a prominent role in your life. You learn much either by her example, or as a result of her mistakes. You seek to nurture others through your career, parenthood, or a public voluntary role. If your Moon is in an Air Sign (Gemini, Libra or Aquarius) then ideas, communication, writing and teaching may appeal. If your Moon is in a Fire sign (Aries, Leo, or Sagittarius) then independence and enthusiasm is a key feature in your career choice. Water Moons (such as Cancer, Scorpio and Pisces) are likely to struggle somewhat early in life with finding a career path. Nurturing others, being of service or finding an artistic profession all ease this process. If your Moon is in an Earth Sign (such as Taurus, Virgo or Capricorn) then you are likely to build solid career paths based on a need for emotional security. In ancient times the Moon was considered to be in a strong position when placed in the angular 10th House of a chart, meaning that you're in a strong position to achieve your ambitions.

The Ascendant

The Ascendant or Rising Sign, is a key - if not the key - component of your Birth Chart. The Rising Sign is time sensitive and therefore considered the most personal point.

Ancient astrologers believed that the Ascendant depicted our primary motivation as individuals. Some believed that it was one of the links to discovering what makes a person happy. When we're accomplishing our primary motivation then we're happy.

The more modern Esoteric astrologers believe that this sensitive chart point reveals a person's soul purpose. And that fulfilling soul purpose contributes to a happy and joyful life. They believe that acceptance of purpose, or fate, can help a person achieve success and satisfaction, and that meditation on the qualities of the Ascendant can help anyone focus on life purpose. A sense of purpose can help overcome the most onerous difficulties in life by taking the focus away from failings and problems and shining a light on strengths and talents.

Esoteric Astrology, the astrology of the soul, espouses that your Sun Sign represents your personality, your Moon your obstacles, and your Ascendant, the way forward.

The Ascendant is in Leo

The Sign of Leo is considered to be 'masculine' by Ancient astrologers suggesting that you're more likely to actively seek your purpose in life, taking the initiative rather than waiting until circumstances are comfortable. Leo is also a Fixed Sign denoting fixity of purpose, resolution, self-reliance and independence.

You're sincere, generous and ambitious, enjoying a sense of autonomy in all that you do. You're adept at organising your own life, and enjoy the independence. Generally speaking, you're assured of your own purpose, and your life is full and eventful. However, there are times when your passion and haste lead to downfalls, and you also have to be wary of the dictum 'pride before a fall'. Fortunately, you're usually back on track quickly thanks to your vital and sunny nature. Other people may be buffeted by the vagaries of fate, but your lessons are connected with will power. In the balance of fate versus free will your purpose is to learn to use your strength of character and strong will power in a positive and powerful manner, rather than simply rebelling against society. You need to shine in your own life but in a way that inspires others rather than in a way that feeds your own ego.

Are you destined to be active, or more sedentary? While the planet Mars is directly

linked to sports and action, your Ascendant can also give you some hints as to the type of exercise that may appeal. In your case, your Leo Ascendant indicates that you are willing to participate in any activity that has an element of fun. Barre pilates, Zumba and such like classes can be enjoyed at your local gym. Or you may prefer to step out in a dance class. You enjoy the company of others, and so a personal trainer can give you the impetus to get moving.

In Esoteric astrology the Rising Sign or Ascendant is considered to be more important than your Sun or Moon Sign. Esoteric Astrology is the astrology of the soul, and the Ascendant is seen as your soul's purpose, or the 'sum of possibilities'. The Sun is seen as your personality, and the Moon as your past. The Ascendant is the moment that your soul chooses for your first breath on planet Earth giving it significance. In Esoteric astrology the Sign of Leo is linked with conviction of spiritual purpose. While it may seem second nature to you, your strength lies in your sure knowledge of your own and other people's purpose. Others may not share your conviction, and this can be your gift to them. You need to be both single-minded in your spiritual purpose and inclusive of other people. Compassion should be your rule of thumb. Your purpose is connected to gaining and sharing a knowledge of both the personal self, and the higher self or soul.

The Ascendant is in the 2nd Decan of Leo

Astrology also allocates different planets to every ten degrees of each Zodiac Sign. These segments are called Decans, and are sometimes referred to as Face. The Decans, or Face, date back as far as the 3rd Millennium BC, and are still used by astrologers in current times. Each Decan influences your Zodiac Sign in different ways, sometimes emphasising and sometimes adding a different flavour to your Zodiac Sign traits. In your case, your Ascendant is in the 2nd Decan of Leo and is ruled by Jupiter. You have a joyful approach to life. You are on a quest to experience as much as possible. No sitting in front of a television or computer screen for hours on end for you! You want to connect with others, take part in small or big adventures and learn, and teach. You truly have the heart of a lion. Anyone with a Leo Ascendant is likely to have a queenly or kingly countenance. You certainly do. You know how to hold court. People are attracted to your passion for life, generosity and warm-hearted nature. At some stage in life, whether you seek it or not, you may be publicly lauded.
